Continue past the Blue Lake School, the 76 Gas Station and the rural housing, stay on this main route approximately 3-4 miles. You will pass the North Fork Lumber Company (previously the Simpson Timber mill) complex on the left and curve right over the concrete North Fork Mad River bridge. Stay straight after the bridge (with more housing on both sides of the road. Just as you start up the hill and just pass the houses on your left, **ON YOUR LEFT** you will see the entrance to Camp Bauer. If you start up the hill, curving to your right you have gone too far!!
